


A Rainy Walk Home Designed by: Sarah Marcina



Off White - Cream	Fourteen (14) 1" x 3" scraps
Periwinkle	10" x 10" square
Forest	3 ½" x 3 ½" square for roof
Jade	Scraps (Umbrella)
Sage	Scraps (Grass)
Tea	Scraps (Dress
Brown	Scraps (Boots)

 Join together the fourteen (14) 1" x 3" off white/cream fabrics. Trim to 8 ½" x 2 ½".






2. Make a 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Half Square Triangle with periwinkle and forest 3" x 3" squares. Use your favorite method.

2. Attach the Half Square Triangle to the top of the strips of fabric from Step One. Unit measures 10 ½" x 2 ½"

4. To the right side of the 10" x 10" square attach the Step 2 unit. Line the bottom of the fabric up. Trim the top of the HST off, resulting in a 10" x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle.

5. To the bottom of the rectangle sew a jade 2 ¾" x 12 ½" strip, resulting in a 12 ½" x 12 ½" square.

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Optional: If you are going to make the Sunbonnet Quilt (a block of the month quilt via Quilt Block Mania), sew the border on the 12 ½" x 12 ½" block prior to appliqueing.


For the border you will need two (2) $2 \frac{1}{2} x 12 \frac{1}{2} and two (2) <math>2 \frac{1}{2} x 16 \frac{1}{2} strips$ of fabric coordinating with the block. Sew the $2 \frac{1}{2} x 12 \frac{1}{2} strips$ onto the sides of the quilt block, press as desired. Sew the $2 \frac{1}{2} x 16 \frac{1}{2} strips$ to the top and bottom of the block. The block measures 16 $\frac{1}{2} x 16 \frac{1}{2}$.

6. Cut out the applique pieces. Add a quarter inch if you desire to turn the edges under. If you are using fusible webbing, follow the package instructions. When printing the templates, make sure to print at 100% not "fit to page."

7. Place the pieces on the 12 1/2"	x 12 ½" block and a	dhere in proper places.	The best order o	of application is a	as follows:

A) Boots B) Dress C) Hand D) Sleeve E) Umbrella

8) Using your favorite marking tool, draw raindrops onto the sky. With blue embroidery floss fill in using a satin stitch. For the umbrella handle use a backstitch.



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
