

| Off White Cream | Fourteen (14) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ " scraps |
| :---: | :---: |
| Periwinkle | $10^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ square |
| Forest | $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square for roof |
| Jade | Scraps (Umbrella) |
| Sage | Scraps (Grass) |
| Tea | Scraps (Dress |
| Brown | Scraps (Boots) |

1. Join together the fourteen (14) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ off white/cream fabrics. Trim to $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

2. Make a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2 \prime$ " Half Square Triangle with periwinkle and forest $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Use your favorite method.
3. Attach the Half Square Triangle to the top of the strips of fabric from Step One. Unit measures $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

4. To the right side of the $10^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ square attach the Step 2 unit. Line the bottom of the fabric up. Trim the top of the HST off, resulting in a $10^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.
5. To the bottom of the rectangle sew a jade $23 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip, resulting in a $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square.


> Optional: If you are going to make the Sunbonnet Quilt (a block of the month quilt via Quilt Block Mania), sew the border on the $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block prior to appliqueing.

> For the border you will need two (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2^{\prime \prime}}$ and two (2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips of fabric coordinating with the block. Sew the $21 / 2 \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips onto the sides of the quilt block, press as desired. Sew the $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the top and bottom of the block.
> The block measures $161 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 161 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
6. Cut out the applique pieces. Add a quarter inch if you desire to turn the edges under. If you are using fusible webbing, follow the package instructions. When printing the templates, make sure to print at $100 \%$ not "fit to page."
7. Place the pieces on the $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ block and adhere in proper places. The best order of application is as follows:
A) Boots
B) Dress
C) Hand
D) Sleeve
E) Umbrella
8) Using your favorite marking tool, draw raindrops onto the sky. With blue embroidery floss fill in using a satin stitch. For the umbrella handle use a backstitch.
