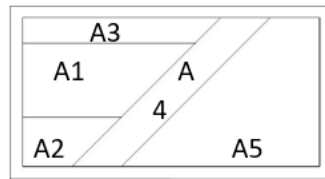

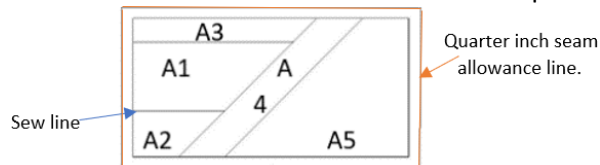
For more information on foundation paper piecing consult a comprehensive quilting book or tutorials.

1. Print the templates and roughly cut a half inch from the outside line. When printing make sure your printer is set at 100% or Print to Size *do not* use the "fit to page" setting.
2. The foundation pieces are numbered in order of how to sew the pieces. The letter on the foundation templates represents the blocks section. Fabric selections are noted beside the template. Example:



A1 – Green
A2 – Concrete gray
A3 – Mulch brown
A4 – Concrete gray
A5 – Sidewalk gray

3. Start with number one's fabric and the foundation's backs against each other. Pin in place. Number two and the following pieces will be sewn right sides of fabric together. Place the second fabric piece right sides together with fabric piece one. Pin in place. Flip the foundation over and sew on the line between A1 and A2. Press open and trim. Repeat the process for piece 3 and onward.



Repeat the process for the subsequent sections.

Tip: Make "Row 2" last as it is the most complex

4. Trim the units to the quarter inch seam allowance line. Join the rows together.

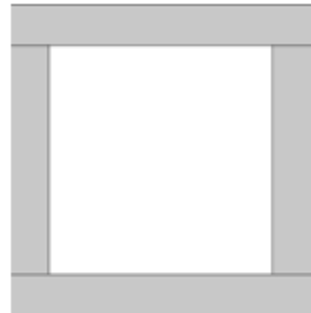
Tip: Each foundation piece page contains one row. Join the rows together as you go for easier block assembly.

5. Sew the sections together as shown in the Block Assembly Diagram.

6. Sew the 2" x 12 1/2" sky blue strip to the top of the block. Sew the 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" concrete gray strip to the bottom of the block. The block measures 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" square.

Optional: *If you are going to make the Sunbonnet Quilt (a block of the month quilt via Quilt Block Mania), sew the border on the 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" block prior to appliqueing.*

For the border you will need two (2) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" and two (2) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" strips of fabric coordinating with the block. Sew the 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips onto the sides of the quilt block, press as desired. Sew the 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" strips to the top and bottom of the block. The block measures 16 1/2" x 16 1/2".

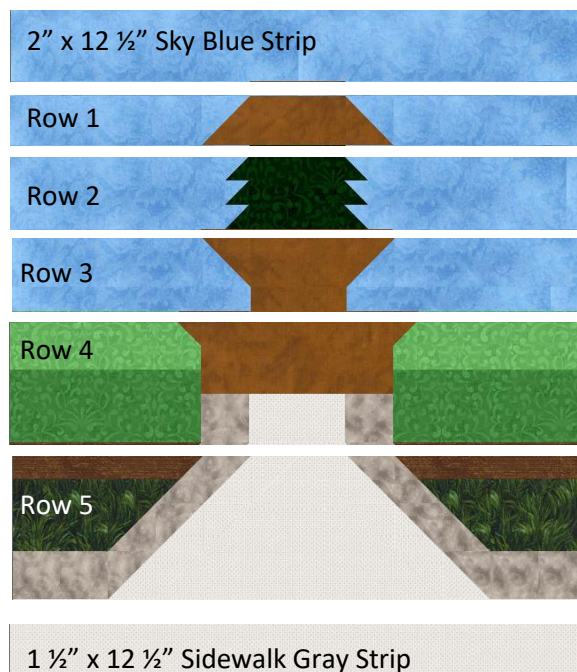


6. For the pineapple fountains top and the sunbonnet family, applique the pieces using your preferred technique.
